The UKPSA Postal League for Practical Shotgun with Slug.

The UKPSA Postal League is open to all shooters and is free to enter. It is made up of four rounds and will total 12 stages. These will be simple to set up, with everyday props, screens and apertures. Some of the stages are standard exercises. The league is ideal for a club practice session or as part of a match.

You can register for the league via <http://shootnscoreit.com/series/ipsc/219/>. You will then be automatically entered into each of the four component matches. You may also fill in the score sheet provided and post in your scores or someone from your club can be authorised to enter the scores online.

Each round will take place as follows

Round 1 in April & May	Round 2 in June & July
Round 3 in August & September	Round 4 in October & November

Scores will be calculated at the end of each round and results will be posted onto the UKPSA web site and Member's Forum. At the conclusion of round 4 overall winners of each division will be declared.

Divisions recognised are Standard, Standard Manual, Modified, & Open

Medals will be awarded in each Division as follows. Over 15 entries, 1st to 3rd. 10 – 14 entries 1st & 2nd. 5 – 9 entries 1st only. Less than 5, no medal.

Team entries will also be accepted for 2016, again free to enter. Three or four team members, all shooting the same division, with the best three scores to count. All team members must be from the same club and should shoot all four rounds to achieve the best scores. Please send your team entry via email to postalleagues@ukpsa.org, stating name of team, team members and division or fill in and post team form below.

Competitors may only shoot **one** division for score. Please note that only your first attempt must be used for your official score. However this does not prevent you from re-shooting in another division for a fun score (no need to send it in).

The stages may be shot at any time within the two-month period for each round. A witness is required to verify the competitor's score.

The stages will be posted out at the start of each round. Scores must be submitted to arrive within 5 days of the last day of each round.

All the stages are simple to set up and organisers are asked to keep to the measurements given. All targets will be the IPSC Mini Target or the IPSC A4 target.

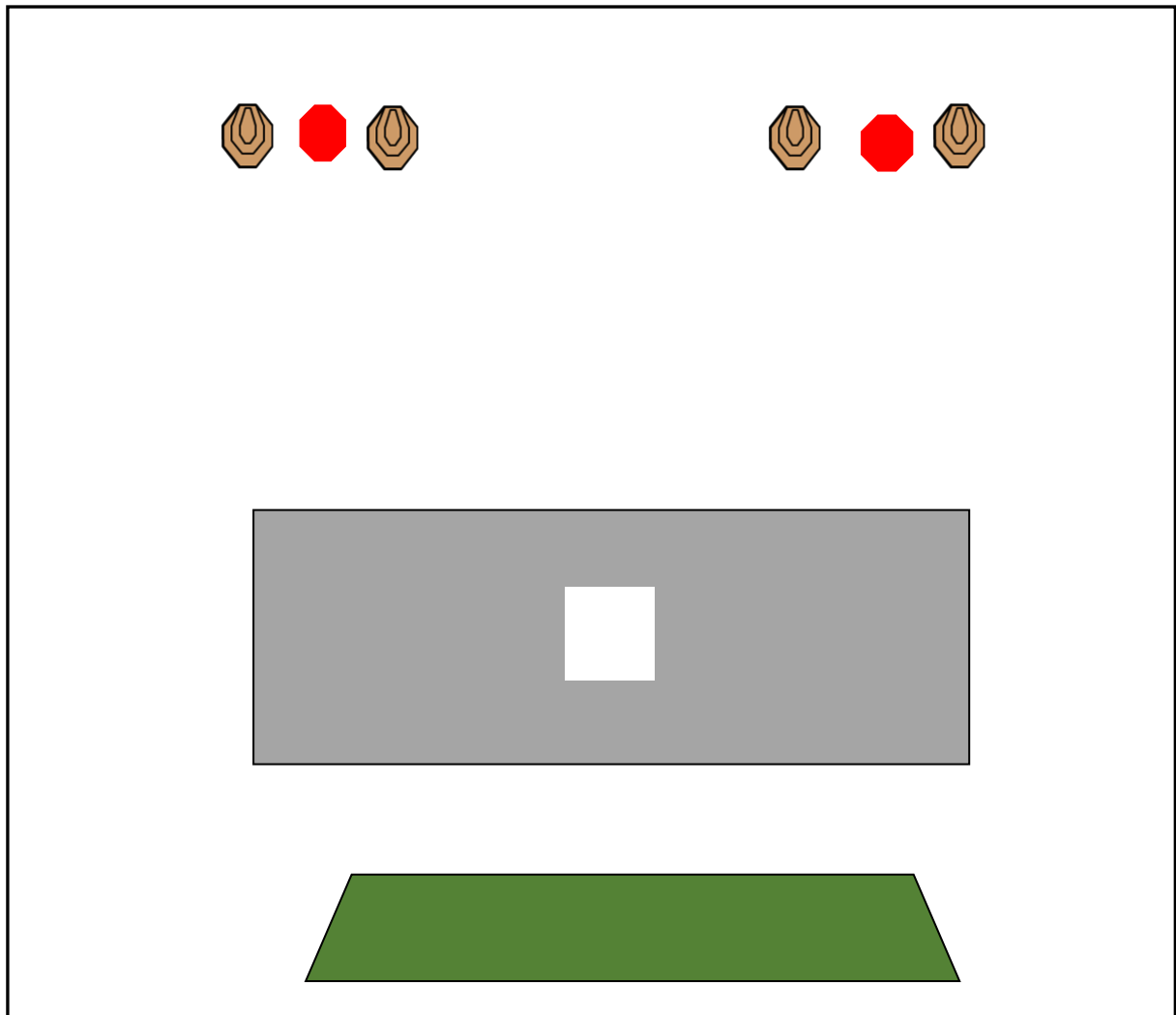

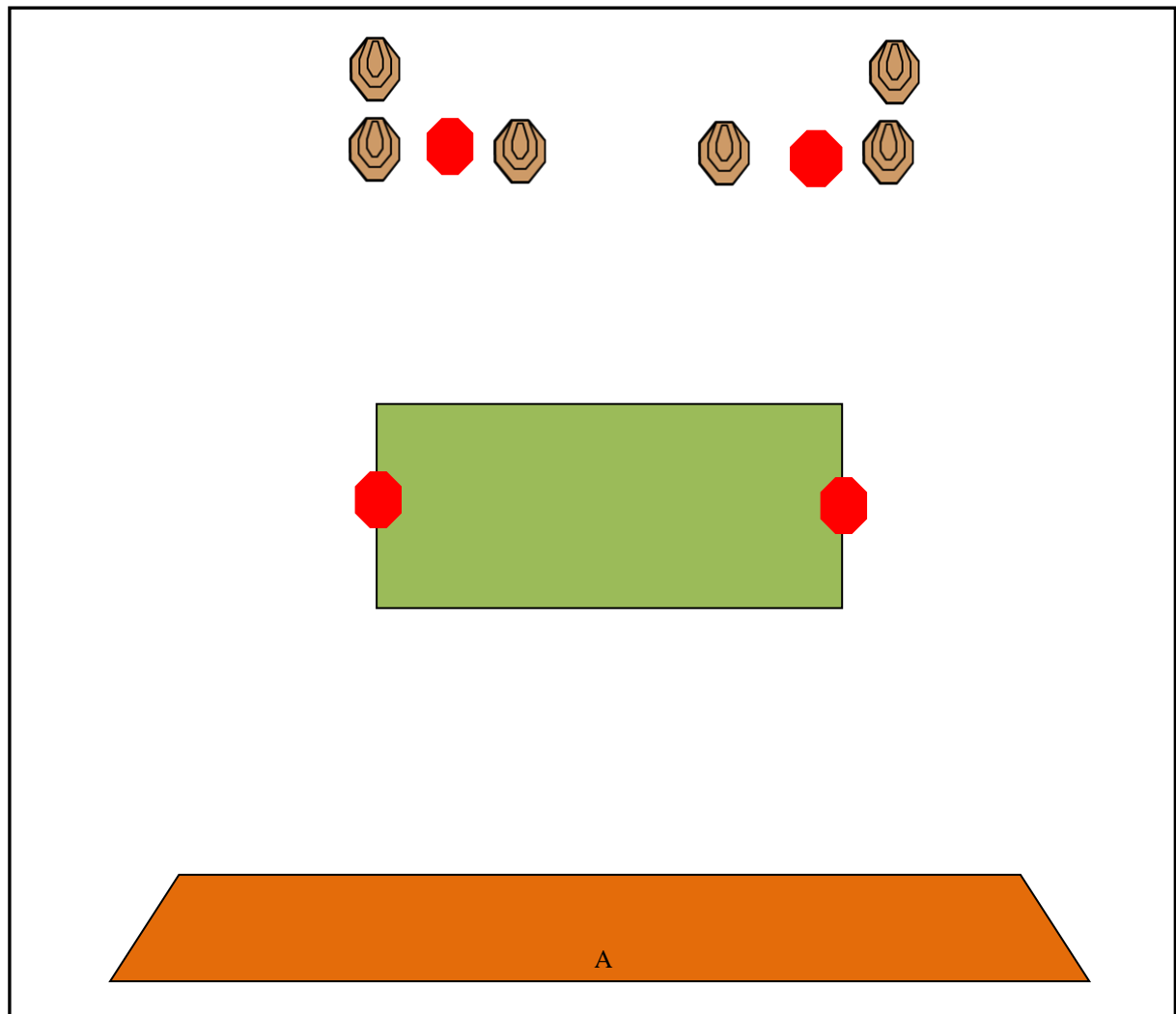

DISTANCES: 10m	MINIMUM ROUNDS TO BE SCORED: 8 Slug
2 SCORING HITS PER PAPER TARGET	MAX POINTS: 40 Points
START POSITION:	Standing in shooting area. Gun loaded Option 1 and held in two hands at waist level, parallel to the ground.
PROCEDURE:	On the start signal, engage all targets, from within the shooting area. All shots must land in the backstop.
DESIGN NOTES:	Barricade approximately 2m in front of shooting area.
BRIEFING NOTES:	Safety Angles 90/90/90. Or Local MAR.

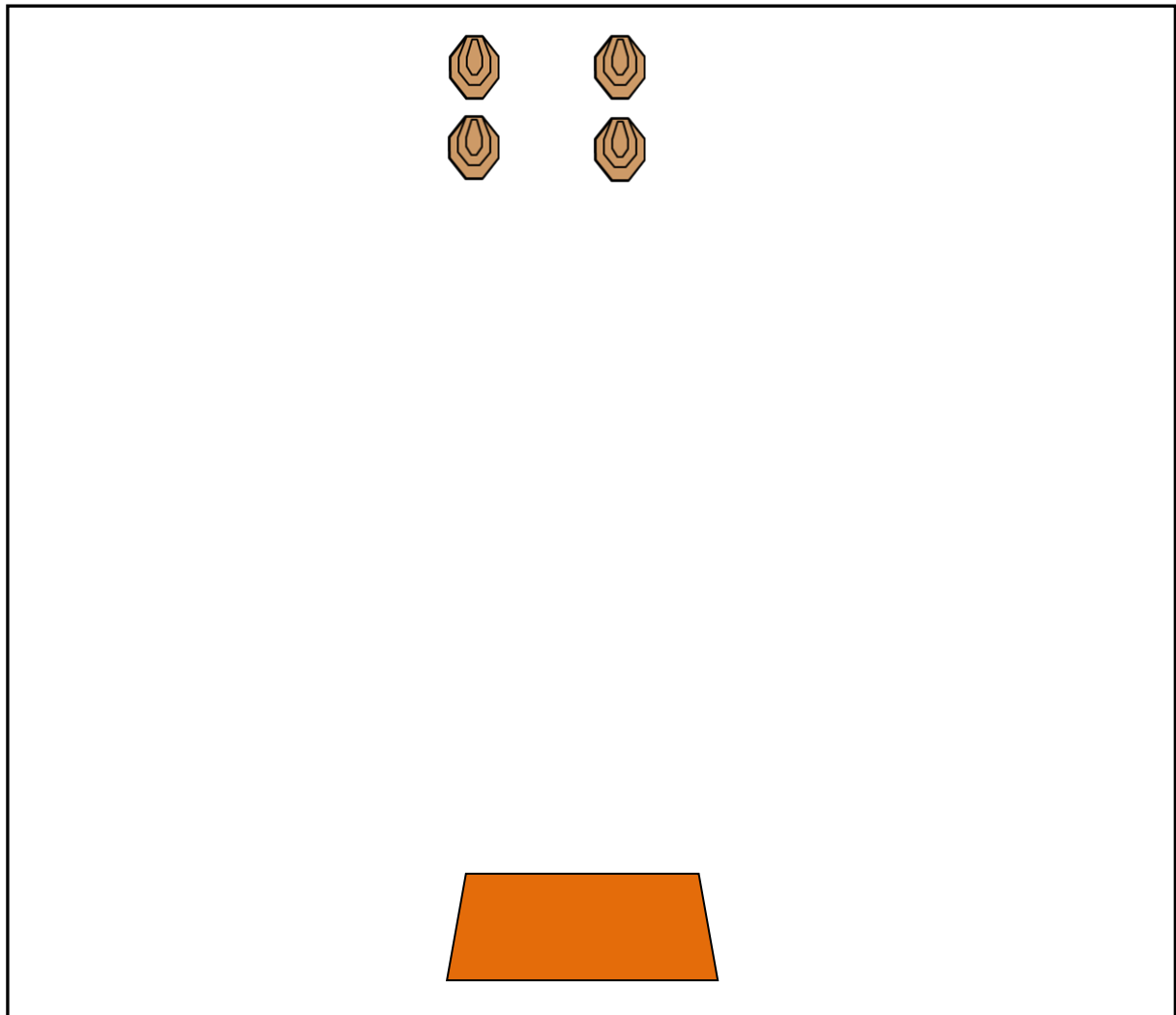

TYPE: Medium course.	TARGETS: 6 IPSC Targets, 4 No-shoot Targets
DISTANCES: 15m	MINIMUM ROUNDS TO BE SCORED: 12 Slug
2 SCORING HITS PER PAPER TARGET	MAX POINTS: 60 Points
	PENALTIES:
START POSITION:	Standing upright at A, Gun loaded Option 2 and held in two hands at waist level, parallel to the ground.
PROCEDURE:	On the start signal, engage all targets, from within the shooting area. All shots must land in the backstop.
DESIGN NOTES:	Barricade approximately 7m in front of shooting area.
BRIEFING NOTES:	Safety Angles: 90/90/90. Or Local MAR.

DISTANCES: 20m	MINIMUM ROUNDS TO BE SCORED: 4 Slug
1 SCORING HIT PER PAPER TARGET	MAX POINTS: 20 Points
PENALTIES:	
START POSITION:	Standing in shooting area. Gun loaded Option 1 and held in two hands at waist level, parallel to the ground.
PROCEDURE:	On the start signal, engage all targets from the weak shoulder, from within the shooting area. All shots must land in the backstop.
DESIGN NOTES:	
BRIEFING NOTES: Safety Angles: 90/90/90. Or Local MAR.
